

2023 Brunswick Hockey Club Uniform Guideline

Uniforms at BHC

The Brunswick Hockey Club uniform is an important part of our club culture and enforces a sense of belonging amongst our members. It is important that all members are wearing current club uniform when playing in Hockey Victoria mandated competitions.

Uniform Accessibility at BHC

We seek to provide low cost club uniform that is accessible for all members. In line with Hockey Victoria's uniform policy we want members to wear the uniform they feel most comfortable in and do not mandate any type of uniform for a specific gender.

Uniform Accessibility at BHC

All uniform is sold to members at cost price. The club does not place a markup on any compulsory club uniforms. Any changes to uniform pricing is due to changes in production costs from our suppliers.

Uniforms in 2023

To mark the club's centenary, the club has developed a centenary playing shirt which includes our centenary logos. This top will be the uniform worn by our Vic League squads in 2023 and may be worn by players in all other teams. It can only be purchased through our online store.

The club will continue to stock our regular playing shirt for purchase at the club.

Uniforms in 2023

In recognition of cost to members and our own sustainability footprint, members who purchase centenary playing shirts will be able to continue wearing these shirts as your playing uniform in future seasons.

Communications have been distributed to our senior Vic League squads regarding the process for ordering your uniform for 2023.

Uniforms in 2023

In 2023 the club will be including playing shorts and skorts as mandatory items of our club uniform for the first time. As many members will be purchasing these for the first time we are only selling these items with our regular club logo.

Stock will be held at the club for members who wish to try on sizes.

Playing Numbers on Uniforms

Hockey Victoria requires all players in junior Shield competitions and senior Vic League competitions to wear numbers on their playing tops. Players from other teams are welcome to have numbers on their shirts but this is not a requirement.

Sponsors on Uniforms

Each year the club seeks to attain sponsorship from a number of local organisations. In return we offer sponsors the opportunity to have their logos present on our Vic League team's uniforms.

Sponsor logos are only expected to be worn by players our Vic League squads.

Home and Away Uniforms

Hockey Victoria requires each club to provide an alternative uniform that is worn when our uniform clashes with our opposition. It is an expectation that all members purchase home and away playing shirts.

In recognition of the cost, the club will be mandating that away uniforms are worn for all away matches, regardless of uniform clashes.


